Majority of Events at Eastman
Springs Saturday Afternoon Are
Taken by Veterans of Famous
Orange and Black.

Standing High Jump.
(1) Derby, Benton Harbor; (2) Keeloo, Niles; (3) Swigrl, Niles. Height—4 feet.

Low Hurdles.
Howard and Armitage of Benton Harbor tied for first place; (2) Huff, Niles.

Pole Vault.
Sharrshore, Lowe and Morrow of Benton Harbor were tied for first but did not care to jump it off. Height—7 feet, 6 inches.

50-Yard Dash.
(1) Armitage, Benton Harbor; (2) Jennings, Benton Harbor; (3) Tal-let, Benton Harbor. Time—6 seconds.

Shot Put.
(1) Huff, Niles; (2) Billel, Niles; (3) Keeloo, Niles. Distance—28 feet, 4 inches.

100-Yard Dash.
(1) Huff, Niles; (2) Armitage, Benton Harbor; (3) Collins, Niles. Time—1:02 seconds.

Running High Jump.
(1) Stone, Benton Harbor; (2) Keeloo, Niles; (1) Barkam, Benton Harbor. Height—5 feet.

220-Yard Dash.
(1) Huff, Niles; (2) Collins, Niles; (3) Armitage, Benton Harbor. Time—30 seconds.

Half Mile Run.
(1) Dick, Niles; (2) Barkam, Ben-ton Harbor; (3) Howard, Benton Harbor. Time—2:30.

Final score—Benton Harbor, 59; Niles, 40. Officials: Bauser and Simon.

In the standing high jump Derby had done 4 feet, 10 inches, but it was not necessary to do it down here. Sharrshore had done 9 feet up at Niles, but the Niles vaulter could not get down. All three places in the 100-yard dash were a surprise for Niles had made first and third up there.
