

# SHELBY LOOKS GOOD

Has No Such Material as Won Last Year's Championship, However.

Shelby, May 15.—Shelby won from Ludington in a dual track meet Saturday on the local field by the score of 98 to 28. Shelby won first place in every event. The best performance of the day was the discus throw by Wilson Beam, 103 feet 6 inches. Orin Kaye made a local track record of 56.1 in the 440-yard dash. Sargent ran the 220 in 24.3, the best local performance of the year. He also ran the 100 in 10.3. In the two-mile run Longnecker lapped Rohrmoser of Ludington on the seventh round of a quarter-mile track and finished 100 yards in front of the nearest competitor. Morrall and Dickle of Shelby tied in the high jump at 5.6.

Shelby has made entries in the Ann Arbor meet for next Friday and Saturday, but has no such material as the team of stars that surprised the state in winning the championship banner last year.
