

INTER-CLASS MEET WON BY JUNIORS

HIGH SCHOOL LADS HOLD ANNUAL CONTEST AT THE COLLEGE FIELD.

COMPETITION IS KEEN

HEALEY OF THE FRESHMEN CLASS IS LARGEST INDIVIDUAL POINT WINNER.

The second annual inter-class track and field meet of the Lansing high school was held at College field Friday afternoon. The juniors carried away first honors with 47 points to their credit. The seniors were second with 28 1-2 points, the sophomores third with 21, and the freshmen last with 27 1-2.

The competition was strong and the score close at all stages and every event was a fight. Until the last events were run off it was not anybody's meet. With but three events remaining the juniors led the seniors by but 4 points while the sophs were but 2 1-2 points behind in third place. The third year men, however, went out in the lead in the first race and were never headed in total points during the meet. By virtue of their victory the 1912 boys will be the first to have their numerals engraved on the silver cup recently purchased by the directors and offered by the Athletic association as the trophy to be competed for at the annual meet.

Freshman Wins Most Points.

Healy, of the freshmen, was the highest individual point winner, adding 18 to his team's standing by virtue of firsts in the broad jump and 220 yard dash and seconds in 100 yard and hurdle events. Harvey was second in this respect with two firsts and one second to his credit, 12 points being his contribution to the sophomore total.
