ANNUAL INTERSCHOLASTIC HELD AT ST. JOHNS.

ST. JOHNS, June 2.—The ninth annual interscholastic track and field meet of Central Michigan will be held at the fair grounds near this city Saturday afternoon and promises to equal if not surpass the meets of previous years.

The program contains the usual list of sports, mile run, several dashes, broad jumps, low hurdles, shot put, hammer throw and a relay race. The schools that will participate in the events are Ionia, Ithaca, Ovid and St. Johns, the number of entries from the different schools being nearly equal.

County Commissioner T. H. Townsend will act as referee of the meet. The judges will be L. E. DeWitt, G. H. Judd and Edward Hulse; timers, W. G. Wykoff and V. E. Stephens; scorer, E. E. Knight; announcer, Gerald Danley. Don Whelan is athletic director.
