

# GRAND RAPIDS WINS OVER BATTLE CREEK AND KALAMAZOO TEAMS

VISITORS SCORE: 52 POINTS  
AGAINST KALAMAZOO'S 42  
IN MEET.

In one of the best track meets ever seen in this city Grand Rapids high school won from Kalamazoo and Battle Creek high schools yesterday afternoon on the Woodward avenue field. The final score was: Grand Rapids, 52; Kalamazoo, 42; Battle Creek, 14.

Battle Creek was sorely handicapped by the loss of four of their best athletes, who were kept from the meet on account of "cons" and only succeeded in pulling down one first place. Kalamazoo picked first in the mile, running broad jump, 440 yard dash, and half mile. Grand Rapids won first in the 100-yard dash, high jump, 220 yard dash, shot put, 120 yard hurdles, discus throw and pole vault.

Osborne of Kalamazoo led in the individual point winning with a total of 19, while Blacklock of the Furniture City was a close second with 18 points to his credit.

Loughead of Kalamazoo was not up to his usual form and fell out of the high jump at five feet. Henshaw, Kalamazoo's miler, had a snap in that event and walked across the tape fully 60 yards ahead of his nearest opponent.

Hudson of Grand Rapids ran a pretty race in the high hurdles and won handily. Osborne had things his own way in the half mile, taking the lead at the start and increasing it to the finish.

440 yard dash—First, Osborne, Kalamazoo; second, Loughead, Kalamazoo; third McClellan, Grand Rapids. Time—55 8-5 sec.

120 yard hurdles—First, Hudson, Grand Rapids; second, Vandenberg, Grand Rapids; third Flugel, Kalamazoo. Time—18 2-5 sec.

Hammer throw—First, Barker, Battle Creek, second, Winoy, Kalamazoo; third, Blacklock, Grand Rapids. Distance—109 ft. 1 in.

Discus throw—First Blacklock, Grand Rapids; second, Osborne, Kalamazoo; third, Flugel, Kalamazoo. Distance—98 ft 8 in.

Pole vault—First, Loveland, Grand Rapids; second Newman, Battle Creek; third Vandenberg, Grand Rapids. Heights—9 ft. 6 in.

Half mile run—First, Osborne, Kalamazoo; second, Henshaw, Kalamazoo; third VanOostenberg, Grand Rapids. Time—3 min. 9 sec.

Relay race (not counted for points)—Grand Rapids, first; Battle Creek second; Kalamazoo, third.
