

NORTH BRANCH WINS

TRACK MEET HELD AT IMLAY CITY YESTERDAY.

Five Lapeer County High School Teams Compete—Cup Awarded to the Victors.

Imlay, City, Mich., June 12.—The annual meet of the Lapeer county Track association, held here Friday afternoon, was won by the North Branch high school for the third consecutive year and the championship cup was awarded to North Branch. A new cup will be put up next year. Five high schools competed in yesterday's events and the points were won as follows: North Branch, 30; Lapeer, 24; Imlay City, 12; Almont, 6; Columblaville, 0.

Yesterday's events and their winners were as follows:

100 yard dash—Zemmer, Lapeer. Time 11 seconds.

Standing broad jump—Payne, North Branch. Distance 9 feet, 4 3/4 inches.

220 yard dash—Zemmer, Lapeer. Time 26 seconds.

Standing hop, step and jump—Payne, North Branch. Distance 27 feet, 11 inches.

Shot put—Mercer, Lapeer. Distance 33 feet, one inch.

Girls' baseball throw—Edith Snyder, Lapeer. Distance 160 feet, 10 inches.

High jump—Payne, North Branch. Height 5 feet 2 inches.

Running broad jump—Payne, North Branch. Distance 18 feet.

Pole vault—Tie between Elliott, Lapeer; Payne, North Branch, and Bishop, Almont. Height 9 feet, 5 inches.

Running hop, step and jump—Payne, North Branch. Distance 39 feet, 9 inches.

440 yard run—Zimmer, Lapeer. Time 56 2-5 seconds.

Half mile run—Root, North Branch. Time 2 minutes, 33 seconds.

Half mile relay—Lapeer relay team. Time 1 minute, 37 seconds.

Following the track events a basketball game was played between Lapeer and Almont and the latter won by a score of 8 to 3.

The referee for the day's events was Prof. F. McComb, of Durand, and the time keeper was Prof. Irwin, of Imlay City.
