

BATTLE CREEK IS WINNER SATURDAY

COPS INDOOR TRACK MEET FROM THE LANSING HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETES.

Harvey of the Local Team Breaks Two Records at Battle Creek.

The Lansing high school indoor track team journeyed to Battle Creek Saturday to meet the Battle Creek high athletes and suffered defeat by a score of 49 to 56. To win from the Lansing aggregation, the lads of the pure food town had to break six of their high school records.

On individual point making, Harvey of Lansing held first place with a total of 14, while Ballinger of Battle Creek copped second with a total of 13. As the Lansing team fell short one man for the broad jumping event, Harvey was urged to enter, and copped first place with a leap of 18 feet 5 1-2 inches, breaking the indoor interscholastic record. Harvey also broke the Battle Creek record for the pole vault, soaring over the bar at a height of nine feet three inches.

The Lansing athletes were at a great disadvantage on the Battle Creek track, which is built on widely different angles from those of the local track and while making a short run to warm up, Hoague sustained a severely sprained ankle and had to be carried out. Mosher, of Lansing, also fell and injured his knee, and the loss of two of the local stars cost Lansing the chance of winning the meet.

The summary of the meet was as follows:

25 yard dash—Cooke, Battle Creek, first; Ballinger, Battle Creek, second; Harvey, Lansing, third. Time, 3 seconds.

220 yard dash—Ballinger, Battle Creek, first; Harvey, Lansing, second; Healy, Lansing, third. Time, 28 4-5 seconds.

440 yard dash—Ballinger, Battle Creek, first; Burns, Battle Creek, second; Healy, Lansing, third. Time, 65 2-5 seconds.

Half mile run—Cooke, Battle Creek, first; Finch, Battle Creek, second; Wellman, Lansing, third. Time, 2 minutes, 16 seconds.

Mile run—Cooke, Battle Creek, first; Jones, Battle Creek, second; Wellman, Lansing, third. Time, 5 minutes, 1 second.

Running high jump—Kelleher, Battle Creek, first; Russell, Lansing, second; Hallstead, Lansing, third. Height, 5 feet 2 inches.

Standing high jump—Kelleher, Battle Creek, first; Halstead, Lansing, second; Golden, Lansing, third. Height, 4 feet 6 1-4 inches.

Running broad jump—Harvey, Lansing, first; Russell, Battle Creek, second; Finch and Reid, Battle Creek, tie for third. Distance, 18 feet 5 1-2 inches.

High dive—Reid, Battle Creek, first; Golden, Lansing, second; Russell, Battle Creek, third. Height, 5 feet 4 inches.

Relay race—Battle Creek, first; Burns, Russell, Ballinger, Bryant; Lansing, second; Cooper, Healy; Harvey, Bennett. Time, 1 minute 28 seconds.
