

ALL TRACK HONORS WON BY LANSING

BATTLE CREEK HIGH IS OUT-CLASSIFIED BY COACH SHASSBERGER'S BOYS.

Capt. Wellman Springs the Surprise of Meet by Taking the Hammer Throw—Baske Captures the Mile.

In probably the classiest high school track meet ever pulled off in Lansing, the athletes representing Lansing high school defeated the boys from Battle Creek to the tune of 63 to 40 yesterday. The gathering was the best dual meet held in the state this year, many of the records hang up being better than those made at the interscholastic meet held at Adrian two weeks ago. Records like 9 feet 7 inches in the pole vault; 18 feet 9 inches in the broad jump, and 33 2-5 seconds for the quarter mile are not made every day. Harvey of Lansing was the individual point winner, he securing a total of 17 1-4 points for his school. The surprise of the meet were the winning of the hammer throw by Capt. Wellman, and the victory of Baske in the mile. For Battle Creek, Burns was the star, securing 24 points, while his teammate, Ballinger, amassed a total of 9 for his school.

Beginning Monday, Athletic Director Shassberger has mapped out for his team a strenuous program of training in preparation for the Central Michigan invitation meet to be held at St. Johns on Saturday, June 1. At this meet Lansing will be compelled to compete against some of the best aggregations in the state. Also, last year's winners of the M. A. C. interscholastic, have a large list of entries for each event and hope to ring up another victory. Summary:
