

NILES TOOK FIRST HONORS

ATHLETE NAMED HUFF WALKED AWAY WITH MOST OF THE POINTS.

SOME RECORDS BROKEN

Dowagiac took second place and St. Joseph third at Purker Field Saturday afternoon—Hance at Ballard Hall in the Evening—Dowagiac Relay Team Defeated For First Time.

Niles captured the honors and first place at the track and field meet in that city Saturday afternoon. Dowagiac took second and St. Joseph third, and Niles can attribute their success to an athlete named Huff, who was able to get over enough points to give Niles over 45 points and take the honors for his team.

The Dowagiac relay team was defeated for the first time in the history of the athletic meet, and Huff of Niles was responsible for that, for when he stepped into the game, the Niles team took the points in that event also.

St. Joseph took third place with thirty-one points. Charles Simon, Fred Herring, Roland Winslow, John Hamilton, Harry Himes, and Rex Wynkoop scoring points for the local school.

The following points were scored: Niles, 52 1/2; Dowagiac 49 1/2 and St. Joe 31. Two records were broken. Huff of Niles broke the intercollegiate record for the hammer and discus throw.

There was a fair-sized crowd present at the event and in the evening a dance was given for the visiting athletes at Ballard's hall. While St. Joseph had to rest content in taking third place, the local boys declare they will have to show them something at the meet next year.

Running broad jump—First, Winslow; second, Catt; third, Wick. Distance, 17 ft. 9 in.

Shot put—First, Huff; second, Neff; third, Hamilton. Distance, 36 feet 8 in.

Hammer throw—First, Huff; second, Allen; third, Hartwell. Distance, 121 ft. 9 1/2 in.

Discus throw—First, Huff; second, Hamilton; third, Catt. Distance, 99 ft. 10 in.

Pole vault—First, Herring; second, Pattison; third, Sewell. Height, 9 ft.

Relay race (One-half mile)—First, Huff; second, Allen; third, Wynkoop.
