

**High School Track Meet at Perry—  
Morrice Winner.**

Morrice, June 3.—The quadrangular track meet held in Perry Saturday was won by Morrice and the pentant was carried off by this school.

McWilliams of the M. A. C., was the outside official and his decisions were considered very fair.

The baseball and tennis events were played before the track meet. Perry first, Morrice second and Bancroft third in baseball.

In tennis a tie resulted, and the final game played Saturday was won by the Morrice girls.

The entire score in the track meet was Morrice 47, Perry 41 and Laingsburg 27, Bancroft 9. Tennis and baseball, Morrice 69, Perry 67, Laingsburg 28, Bancroft 14.

The highest individual number of points won by anyone was won by Black of Laingsburg, who had 19 in his favor. Second highest, Leo Cunningham, Morrice, 17; third, Clifford Jarrad, Morrice, 13.
