Lansing's representatives at the interscholastic held at Detroit on Saturday failed to place in any of the events entered. Capt. Wellman was entered in the hammer throw and could not score against Cross of Wayne, who threw the pill 141 feet 2 inches. Bement was slated for the quarter, but was unfortunate in being drawn for the same heat as was the winner of the finals. He brought in a third, but only firsts and seconds qualified for the finals. The pace in the half mile, which was won in 2 minutes 4 seconds, proved too fast for Baske, and he had to be content with finishing seventh in a field of 17 starters. He was unfortunate in drawing the 16th position on the track at the start. Raymond in the discuss pulled a fifth place against a field of 30 entries, just outside of the prize money. In the broad jump he finished sixth in a field of about 40 starters.
