

GRAND LEDGE WINS EATON FIELD MEET

**HIGH SCHOOL BOYS CAPTURE
FROM CHARLOTTE BY
ONE POINT.**

**Vermontville Defeats Olivet at Base-
ball by 5 to 4 Score for Cham-
pionship of League—Weyant
Pitches Good Ball.**

CHARLOTTE, June 10.—Vermontville by a very narrow margin won the Eaton county high school championship baseball game from Olivet, last year's title holder, by a score of 5 to 4, Saturday. Grand Ledge captured the annual field and track meet, winning over Charlotte by only one point, Eaton Rapids being third.

Four of the high school teams in the Eaton County Athletic association were on hand with many supporters. Bellevue failed to show up and was not represented by a single man. Grand Ledge, however, sent down a strong home guard. Mark Pascoe of Eaton Rapids, who was his team's best point getter last year, carried off the individual honors by securing four first medals out of his five entries. Stealy, Dodge, Milbourn and Satterly starred for the Charlotte team, and Halsted, Foote and Colville for Grand Ledge. The field meet was held at the fair grounds here, the ball game at Bennett park adjoining. Following are the winners of the meet:

100-yard dash—First, Pascoe, Eaton Rapids; second, Stealy, Charlotte; third, Dodge, Charlotte. Time, 11 1-5 seconds.

220-yard dash—First, Pascoe, Eaton Rapids; second, Satterly, Charlotte; third, Hartauf, Charlotte; fourth, Morton, Charlotte. Time, 2 1-5 seconds.

440-yard run—First, Stealy, Charlotte; second, McCormick, Grand Ledge; third, Baker, Grand Ledge. Time, 3 2-4 seconds.

Half mile run—First, Dodge, Charlotte; second, Baker, Grand Ledge; third, Foote, Grand Ledge. Time, 2 minutes, 30 seconds.

One mile run—First, Milbourn, Charlotte; second, Niles, Grand Ledge; third, Wildern, Charlotte; fourth, McLawson, Grand Ledge. Time, 5 minutes, 8 2-5 seconds.

120-yard hurdles—First, Pascoe, Eaton Rapids; second, Holland, Grand Ledge; third, Milbourn, Charlotte. Time, 18 seconds.

High jump—First, Satterly, Charlotte; second, Colville, Grand Ledge; third, Halsted, Grand Ledge. Height, 5 feet, 3 inches.

Broad jump—First, Pascoe, Eaton Rapids; second, Satterly, Charlotte; third, Halsted, Grand Ledge. Distance, 18 feet, 4 3-4 inches.

Pole vault—First, Halsted, Grand Ledge; second, Wamsamaker, Olivet; third, Satterly, Charlotte. Height, 9 feet, 3 inches.

Shot—put—First, Colville, Grand Ledge; second, Foote, Grand Ledge; third, Pascoe, Eaton Rapids; fourth, Stone, Charlotte. Distance, 36 feet, 11 3-4 inches.

Discus throw—First, Fountain, Eaton Rapids; second, Foote, Grand Ledge; third, Colville, Grand Ledge. Distance, 91 feet, 1 inch.

Relay race—First, Eaton Rapids; second, Charlotte.
