

## TRACK HONORS TO DOWAGIAC BOY

PLUMMER, U. OF M. ATHLETE,  
CAPTURES FIFTEEN POINTS  
IN ST. JOSEPH MEET.

Plummer of Dowagiac, University of Michigan athlete carried off honors in the southwestern Michigan track and field meet in this city Thursday afternoon. He took first in the fifty and 100 yard dashes and first in the 440 yard run winning fifteen points. He was closely pressed by his team mate Allen, who won three seconds and a third for a total of thirteen points. Huff of Niles was third with twelve points.

### St. Joseph Boys Prominent.

St. Joseph boys were prominent in the events. Allen Honey, a student at the University of Michigan, winning first in the 880 yard run and second in the shot put. Herring was an easy winner in the pole vault and Delaney captured honors in the shot put.

Rollin Winslow won the half mile swimming event and Eugene Peare, who spends his summers here, took the medal in the fifty yard water dash.

### Thousands Witness Meet.

The track and field events were held on Lake boulevard between Broad and Hatch streets and attracted the best amateur athletes of this section of the state. Thousands of people witnessed the meet and rooted enthusiastically for their favorites. The meet proved to be one of the biggest attractions of the day. A silver medal was given each winner.
