

CENTRAL TEAM OUTCLASSES THE ANN ARBORITES

Expected Opposition Fails to Materialize and Blue and White Bombs In.

**ROBINSON IS SURPRISE
IN THE MILE EVENT**

Final Score of Events is 61 to 33, With the Detroiters Leading.

Central bade farewell to its 1913 track season by handing Ann Arbor a decisive 61 to 33 trimming, Saturday evening in the Cass avenue gym.

Ann Arbor, touted as a formidable opponent for the Blue and White school to meet unaccounted rather easily to the skill and speed of Coach Collins' boys. At the outset of the meet Central scooped in all, or nearly all, the loose points but the Arborites took a brace against the middle portion of the affair, being near to taking the lead from the Blue and White team. The Detroiters, universally loved boys came, however, was right after the knockout when the score stood 25 to 25.

Central Takes First.

Central topped the first two places in the mile and first in the broad jump, which insured a victory for the Blue and White. Had the Arborites taken over places in the pole vault, and won the relay they still would have been one point shy of winning. As it turned out Wilson and "Doc" Tillotson won first and second in the pole while the Central runners took the relay easily and thus rolled up a tremendous lead.

The boys who pulled down seconds and thirds for Central were the real winners of the meet, as Ann Arbor won five times—enough to offset Central's quietest.

The real surprise of the meet was the winning of the mile run by Robinson, who was competing for the first time. This win gives him the right to sport the "C" of his chest. Besides Robinson, Louie Wilson, Brown and the Tillotson boys were the lads who starred for Central. Edwards, Wycoff, Shouford and Church were the main spruces of the Ann Arbor team.

Wilson of Central set the gym record for the pole vault at 10 feet 10 inches. The previous record was 10 feet and the bar was raised for Wilson's benefit after all the other had been outclassed.
