Incidentally, the first three places of the meet were taken by Chicago schools and the Michigan Institutions were left out in the rain. 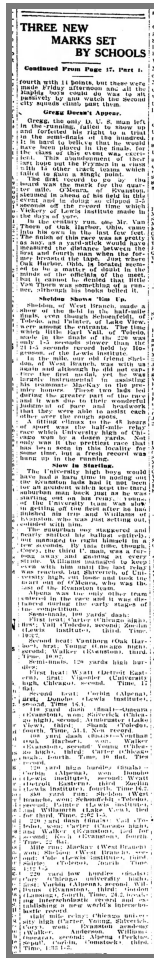
