

TO PICK TEAMS FOR "RELAY CARNIVAL"

With scarcely a week left in which to prepare for the big "relay carnival," to be held under the auspices of the Lansing high school athletic association at the old race track grounds next Saturday, Coach Shasberger of L. H. S. has mapped out a strong program of work for his athletes. Three races will be run in the "carnival," half-mile, mile and two-mile relays.

Tuesday night the best of the 220-yard dash boys in the high school will be tried out, and the four who make the fastest time will be chosen as the half-mile team. Wednesday night the fastest half-mile runners in the school will be tested, and the best four picked for the two-mile relay. Thursday the quarter-milers will be raced and a mile-relay team picked.

Expect to Win Half-Mile.

Judging from the time made the half-mile relay team in the dual meet with Battle Creek, Lansing ought to win this event next Saturday. Harvey, Prine, Sprang and Healey stepped the distance in the remarkably good time of 1 minute and 39 seconds, which is within about two seconds of the Michigan interscholastic record. With careful coaching the boys should better their mark of 1:39. Lansing won this event from practically the same team which Battle Creek had at the interscholastic meet a year ago, winning the race.

Here is the record of the meet with Battle Creek. Final score: Lansing 73, Battle Creek 38.

440-yard dash—Webber, B. C. first; Hodson, Lansing, second; Ebing'er, Lansing, third. Time—55 1/5 seconds.

Broad jump—Halstead, Lansing, first; Sprang, Lansing, second; Healey, Lansing, third. Distance—18 feet, 5 1/2 inches.

Mile run—Mahan, B. C. first; E. Roscoe, Lansing, second; Bailey, Lansing, third. Time—5:27.

Relay race—Won by Lansing. (Harvey, Prine, Sprang, Healey). Time—1:39. Great time.
