## HIGH WINS IN

WATER TIE FOR  
SECOND.

### MANY RECORDS BROKEN

Sheldon of West Branch Knocks  
Off Ten Seconds in Mile

Run.

LANSING, June 7.—Grand Rapids won the seventh annual Michigan interscholastic track and field meet at the Michigan Agricultural college this afternoon with a total of 21 2-3 points. Detroit Eastern and Coldwater tied for second place with 18 points, and West Branch finished third with a score of 12.

Blacklock, the largest individual point winner in the meet, was the mainstay of the Grand Rapids team. He took first place in the shot put and hammer throw, grabbed a third in the high hurdles and won a fraction of a point in the high jump. This work won for him the medal as largest individual point winner. Sheldon, of West Branch, was second with 10 points. He won the mile and half mile.

Exceedingly good time was made in the different events, despite the fact that the wind was cold and raw and the track was made heavy by last night's rain.

Van Aken, of Coldwater, set a new state interscholastic record for the 440-yard dash by finishing in 52 2-5 seconds. The old record of 54 seconds was set by Howard, of Crosswell, in 1912. Sheldon, of West Branch, clipped 10 seconds from the mile run when he negotiated the distance in 4:33 3-5. The former record, made by Cowley, of Muskegon, has stood since 1909.
