

STATE TRACK HONORS WON BY G. R. CENTRAL

Hugh Blacklock Is All Around Star in Event at Lansing on Saturday.

Lansing, June 9.—Grand Rapids Central High athletes won the seventh annual Michigan interscholastic track and field meet here on Saturday mainly through the efforts of Hugh Blacklock, the largest individual point winner in the meet. Grand Rapids scored 23 2-3 points. Coldwater and Detroit Eastern athletes tied for second place with 18 points each.

Blacklock was at his best in the weight events, taking first in the shotput and hammer throw. He also won a fraction of a point in the high jump and finished third in the high hurdles.
