

# Seniors Capture Annual L. H. S. Inter-Class Meet

## Baske Breaks Local Half-Mile Record in Down-Pour of Rain—Lansing Meets Alma Saturday.

**TY COBB FORGETS PREPARED SPEECH AT JACKSON BANQUET.**

JACKSON, April 29.—Manager Hughey Jennings and outfielder Ty Cobb of the Detroit team spent an off day Monday preparing speeches to deliver at the baseball dinner celebrated here Monday night. Cobb forgot his speech, but gave a remarkably good extemporaneous talk, although he appeared somewhat ill at ease and frequently announced that he was embarrassed.

Hughey Jennings carefully refrained from making any allusion to the Detroit club, but spoke of baseball generally. At the close he recited a poem, "Stars of Days Gone By."

The dinner attend by perhaps 400 fans, was in honor of Manager "Mo" Myers and members of the Jackson team.

The senior class of the high school carried off the honors at the annual inter-class track meet held at M. A. C. last night, by scoring more points than all the rest of the classes put together. Some good marks, considering that it rained during most of the meet, were hung up. The half mile was won by Baske in the record time of 2:10. This breaks the high school record formerly held by Francisco, who made the distance in 2:14 2-5 in 1910. Harvey cleared 19 feet 6 inches in the broad jump. The meet serves as a try-out for the men whom Coach Shassberger will take with him to Alma Saturday.
