

Lansing High Tri-Angul Smash Se

Local Lads Win Twelve Firsts -- Will Make Them Favorites For The Interscholastic Honors

Lansing high school captured the tri-angular track meet with Ann Arbor and Jackson at the latter city Saturday afternoon by scoring nearly two-thirds of the points. Incidentally Coach Schasberger's men broke seven local high school records and strengthened the predictions that they will take first honors in the Michigan interscholastic meet at East Lansing in June.

Despite the one-sided result, the L. H. S. lads were forced to the limit. Harvey was the individual star of the meet. He took three firsts, tied for first place in two other events and hung up new marks in the low hurdles and quarter mile events. Healy also smashed two marks. Baake took the half mile and mile in record time. Lansing took 12 out of 14 firsts and scored 78 points, Ann Arbor getting 28 and Jackson 29.

Coach Schasberger will take his men to Ann Arbor Friday to compete at the invitation high school meet. Chicago, Detroit, Toledo, Cleveland and other leading high schools of the mid-west will send teams to Ann Arbor.
