

TILDEN SHOWS BEST IN GRAMMAR SCHOOL MEET

By Taking Relay Race the Winners Nose Out Fairbanks by a Single Point in Fine Meet—Goldner and Smith Do Best Work of Day—Thomas School Romps in With Baseball Honors.

After the Fairbanks school athletes had led the contest portions in the annual grammar school meet, at Kingswood, Tilden school, by virtue of taking second place in the 100-yard dash, put itself in striking distance of the winners when it went out and won the relay race to take down the honors by a single point, finishing with 27 points to Fairbanks' 26.

Goldner, Morley, Grinnell, Stewart and Smith were the relay men who secured the verdict in favor of their school. The 100-yard dash, negotiated the distance in 11.15 seconds, very good time for this age, while the surprise of the meet was the pole vault by Thomas school, who was considered a rank outsider at the start but came through with a jump of 8 feet 9 inches to win.

Good Work in High Jump.
In the high jump, Stewart Smith cleared the bar at 5 feet to take the verdict.
By winning the meet, Tilden school secured the Jarvis trophy cup. Fairbanks school wins the Central high trophy for class A relay, while Tilden takes the one for class B relay.
