

## Lansing High Wins Relay and Gets Fifth Place at Prep Meet

Healey's wonderful run in the last lap of the Class A half-mile relay at the Michigan Interscholastic track meet Saturday at East Lansing, gave the classic event to Lansing high school.

The finish was the most exciting of any event of the meet. Lansing drew the outside place on the track. Harvey, Ehinger and Sprang ran well but when Healey started on the last lap he was nearly 10 yards behind the Bay City Eastern man. By a final spurt, he went to the tape six inches ahead of the field.

Detroit Eastern took first honors with a total of 25 points. Bay City Eastern crowded the Detroit boys hard with 23 points. Lansing was fifth with 12 5-6 points.
