

"Y" SQUAD WINS DUAL TRACK TILT

**Beats Eastern High Aggregation
in Annual Meet by 63 to 32—
Both Teams Uncover Some
Good Prospects.**

That both the Detroit Y. M. C. A. and Eastern high will have pretty fair track teams in their respective classes this season was illustrated in the "Y" gymnasium Thursday evening during the practice dual meet held annually by these institutions.

The "Y," of course, captured first honors with 63 points while the high school boys accumulated 32. It was the initial official performance for both teams and, taking this into consideration, the results were pretty good.

Gleason, who is a comer in prep school ranks, starred for the Eastern squad securing 15 points, getting first in the 25-yard dash and pole vault, second in the low hurdles and a tie for second in the high jump.

He also threatened to finish either one, two in the 220-yard sprint until slipping on the far turn and falling down, putting him out of the running entirely. His slightly sprained his wrist and it was feared he would be out of the pole vault but he managed to hold his own after having his wrist tightly bandaged, winning with 9 feet 6 inches.

Will Holster Team.

Although the "Y" aggregation didn't look as good as it was expected the squad will be bolstered by the addition of Jacobs, star hurdler and jumper. He was expected to compete Thursday but didn't appear. The winners failed to develop the looked-for ability in the hurdles too but Dr. Modisetti stated that several new men who recently joined the squad would strengthen the team in the jumps for future competitions.

The mile run developed a pretty race between MacDonald, of the "Y," and Snyder, of Eastern. The latter ran a fine race for an inexperienced competitor, finishing a close second. When he learns to gauge his pace better he will be a dangerous man in the distance runs. Time for the race was 5:08.
