

## CASSITES LOSE TO COLT SQUAD

**Northwestern High Easily Wins  
Track Meet, 60 to 24; Isbell  
Runs Mile in 4:53.**

That Northwestern high will cut quite a swath in state scholastic track circles was proved in the Northwestern gymnasium Friday afternoon when Coach Maris's Colts ran away with a dual indoor meet, beating Cass Tech by 60 to 24.

Jimmy Clark was the only man who saved the Cass boys from a much worse trimming, taking three firsts. He won the 30-yard dash, low hurdles and high jump. Cass was also awarded the relay on a foul. The Tech team was crippled by the ineligibility of several of its best men.

Isbell furnished the star performance of the afternoon by winning both half and mile runs for Northwestern. He ran the mile in 4:53, which is the best time recorded in local competition this winter. At that, he was not pressed. By the time the big meets roll around, this lad should be in shape to uncork sensational performances in the distance events.
