

## PONTIAC EASY FOR LOCALS IN DUAL CONTEST

### Northwestern High Tracksters Win Indoor Meet by Score of 64 to 22.

Northwestern high's tracksters added another victory to their unbroken chain at the expense of Pontiac Friday evening in the Detroiters' gymnasium, the final score being 64 to 22.

Pontiac showed only one man with enough class to bother the locals, and although he did his duty, none of his companions was able to help enough to make the meet interesting. Cowan was the star of the Asylum City squad and he also bagged more points than any other man in the meet, being responsible for 15 of his team's 22 counters. He got these by taking first in the 25-yard dash, second in the 200, the hurdles and the high jump, and a lone point in the shotput, proving himself a versatile young man.

Burns and Isbell split honors for the 220 Colts. The former scored first in the 220 and 40, while Isbell got his 10 points through firsts in the mile and the half. Burns also helped win the relay for the Colts. This had made good time in his events, but Isbell let down when no competition was in sight and the mile was unusually slow at 7:30.5.

The Colts took all three places in the half when Downie and H. Williams followed Isbell in the tape in the order named, in three events, the mile, the pole vault, and the 40, the Colts also scored heavily, taking firsts and seconds.

Mason, J. Williams, Sprung and Burnham were responsible for the remainder of the points scored. Sprung was the only man who had any trouble at all in competing for his first, being hard pressed by Cowan. The relay went to the Colts in fast time, Chappeu, Pierce, Kritz and Burns having no difficulty in snatching the points.
