

# EASTERN GIVES COLTS BEATING IN DUAL MEET

## Indians Spring Surprise by Winning Indoor Track Contest, 59½ to 31½.

Eastern high's tracksters put an end to all the championship aspirations of the Northwestern high squad in the Boulevard gymnasium Friday evening, trouncing the Colts, 59½ to 31½.

Eastern's expected superiority in the field events was apparent throughout, and when some of the Colt dash men fell down in their events, the Indians rolled up a big score.

Close races resulted in the mile and the half, both of which were won by Isbell of Northwestern. In the mile he was pushed by Schneider, who nearly made up in his sprint the margin gained by the Colt man in the first portion of the race. The time of this event was 4:57 1-8. In the half, Walbridge gave chase to the Colt flyer, and ran a pretty second, forcing Isbell to go 2:16 4-8 to win.

**Wickham Was Disqualified.**  
The high hurdles event resulted in a classic. In the finale Wickham, the Colt entry, ran away from the field and was declared winner by the judges. Dr. Madocott, referee and starter, declared the race foul, claiming that the Northwesterner had beaten the gun. He ruled that the race be run over, which Northwestern refused to do, and Madocott immediately declared the points gained by Wickham thrown out. This action gave Eastern a first and second in the event.

In two events, the high jump and the 440, all the points went to the one team. The high jump saw Eastern cop all nine points when Spurrier, Gleason and Westbrook tied at 5 feet 2 inches. In the 440, Burns, Dermody and Kritz scored a clean over the Eastern entries. Burns had also been the favorite in the 220, but the heat he got in this event was a third.

**Gleason Gets 17 Points.**  
Gleason, of the Eastern contingent, was the individual point winner, being responsible for 17 points. Westbrook came in next for the winners. Isbell, with two points, was the big man for the losers.
