

GRAND RAPIDS TAKES HONORS ' ON THE TRACK

**Records Galore Are Smashed
and Two Other Marks Are
Equalled in Kazoo Meet.**

Kalamazoo, Mich., May 6.—Grand Rapids Central with 40 points won the second annual Kalamazoo college interscholastic here today, taking five of the 14 firsts.

New records were made in the mile, half mile, 50, 220 and 440 dashes, while the shot-put and the century time was equalled.

Roy Workman of Plainwell won the individual cup, with 13 1-2 points, with Merchant of St. Joseph running a close second with 13. St. Joseph with but two men entered took second honors in the meet with 21 points. Kalamazoo and Plainwell tied at 17 1-3, Ann Arbor followed with 14, Paw Paw with 11 and Detroit Central with 7. Grand Rapids Central won the silver shield and the relay banner, together with a stack of gold, silver, and bronze medals and several ribbons.
