

PREP MEET IS WON BY TWO LADS

Landers and Loomis, of Oregon,
Ill., Score 34½ Points, Ac-
quiring Comfortable Margin
Over Nearest Rival.

MARKS ARE SHATTERED IN SEVERAL EVENTS

High Wind Blowing Down
Stretch Prevents New Record
in 220 Dash—Detroit High
Schools Get Places.

AN ARIZON, Mich., June 4.—
Two capable youngsters from
Oregon, Illinois, swept through
a brilliant interscholastic field meet
on Perry field this afternoon to a
victory by a comfortable margin over
all contenders.

These two athletes amassed a total
of 34½ points, leading Scott high
school by 15½ points. Grand Rapids
Central high school was third
with 19 points, with out of state
schools taking nearly all the rest.
Detroit Eastern came through with
three, as did Muskegon. Northwest-
ern of Detroit made two points with
Shelby also counting that number.

The two winners, Landers and
Loomis, were the only individuals
who won more than one event. Landers
won the 100-yard dash and the 200-
yard dash, and Loomis won the
100-yard dash and the 200-yard dash.
Landers' victory in the 100-yard dash
was a clean sweep of the event, as
he was the only one who entered.
Loomis won the 200-yard dash for
and fourth place in the meet.

Wind Prevents 220 Record.

It had been hoped for the first time
a high wind blowing down the stretch
would make the 220-yard dash an
official new mark would have gone
to the Detroit Eastern. The Detroit
Eastern's interscholastic record and
mark in the 220-yard dash was
established last season, and it was

this year. However, the high wind
in the stretch made it impossible
for any runner to attempt the record.
