

ANNUAL Y. M. C. A. CROSS COUNTRY RUN IN CITY

**Instead of Staging Thanksgiv-
ing Event at Belle Isle, Lo-
cal Organization Will Start
Race Out North Woodward.**

It has been decided to conduct the annual Y. M. C. A. Thanksgiving cross-country run on the streets of the city of Detroit. The race will start at 12 o'clock noon. The length of the course will be about three and one-half miles and will start out North Woodward, finishing at Grand Circus park. More than 100 runners, made up of teams from the high schools and colleges and representatives from the State university, Agriculture college, Albion college, will compete. Cups will be given to the institution having the largest number of entrants finish the course.

The noon Business Men's club of the Y. M. C. A. has organized a "Liberty league" to promote volley ball, basketball, handball, swimming and rifle shooting. There are teams competing in each sport representing the army, navy, marine corps and aviation corps. The officers are: A. C. Boone, of the American Can company; George Yost, furrier; Douglas Warren, of Parke, Davis & Co. Rev. William J. Jacobs, of the Boulevard Congregational church, directs the affairs of the league.
