

NORTHWESTERN BEATS EASTERN IN DUAL MEET

Indians Lose by 22-Point Margin When Gleason Is Out With Blood-poisoning.

Northwestern high school tracksters won the dual meet in their own gymnasium Friday evening with Eastern high, winning by 53 1-2 points to 26 1-2.

The meet would have been much closer had the losers not been crippled by the absence of Gleason, their star performer, who is laid up with blood-poisoning at present. Gleason carries six points for the Easterners and those in which he would have been entered but for his illness, were captured by Northwestern.

Eastern took only two flats, a 380 and mile runs, and also won the relay race which was one of the feature performances of the evening. Good results were obtained in the quarter, half and mile, the first being made in one minute, the second in 2:15.2 and the third in 4:28.1. Walbridge ran a clever race in the 380, while Snyder won the mile. Eastern also split points for first in the high jump at 5 feet 5 inches.

Spring and Wickham were consistent performers for the Collis. Spring scored 18 points besides running in the relay. Wickham contributed 3 1-2 points to his team's total. Northwestern is taken care of pretty well in the dashes and hurdles, but could stand improvement in the distances and field events. Eastern has a fairly well-balanced aggregation with Gleason in the meet but is shy in hurdles, dashes and field events.
