

## NORTHEASTERN BOYS DO WELL IN LAST MEET

**Hold Ann Arbor High to Four-  
Point Winning Margin in  
Indoor Dual Contest.**

Ann Arbor high's track team barely beat the Northeastern high team in the latter's gymnasium Friday by 40 1-2 to 36 1-2 points in a dual track and field contest.

Coach Armstrong's boys made the best showing that they have exhibited this season, doing particularly well in the distance runs and the relay. Their performance against Ann Arbor, which school has a pretty fair aggregation of tracksters this year, was rather unexpected, as the Northeasterners have been slow in developing.

Ann Arbor scored firsts in the short dash, low hurdles, high jump and shotput, the remaining events having been taken by the Detroiters. This meet winds up the indoor track competition in Detroit for the year. Northeastern's 105-pound relay runners captured two races from the Marcy school teams, thereby having undisputed claims to the city title.
