

Large Entry List Assured at Kalamazoo

Kalamazoo, May 16—Although a large number of high schools in this section of the state have called off athletics for the remainder of the year, a large entry list for the second annual Western State Normal interscholastic track and field meet is assured for Saturday, May 19.

Grand Rapids Central was the first school to mail entries for the class "A" meet. Athletic Director "Dinnie" Upton has entered eleven men, including Jacob Vande Visse, reputed to be the state's best half mile and mile runner, Guy Houston, sprinter and Bob MacKenzie, hurdler. Three Oaks and Wayland were the first schools to send in entries for the class "B" meet.

On account of the division of the meet and the subsequent opening of class "A" events at 9:30 in the morning, it becomes necessary for a number of the visiting teams to arrive on Friday afternoon. They will be quartered with normal men or in Kalamazoo hosteleries.

Eastern high is the first Detroit school to send in its entry list.
