

LANSING HI TRACK TEAM ENTER MEET

Local School Sends Eleven Entrants to Kazoo Nor- mal Tourney.

Lansing high school has entered 11 men in the class "A" events of the Western Normal interscholastic track and field meet, to be held Saturday, May 19, on the beautiful 14-acre athletic field at the Kalamazoo school.

In the Normal's first annual meet, held a year ago, Lansing men scored 11 points, taking a place in the first division of point winners. In the Kalamazoo college meet, held May 5 of this year, Lansing scored third place, being bested only by Grand Rapids Central and Kalamazoo. It is expected the capital city lads will make a strong run for honors at Saturday's meet.

Gold, silver and bronze medals for the first three places in each event, with a ribbon for fourth, a handsome bronze shield to the winning team and another to the winning relay quartet, with a silver loving cup to the individual high point winner, are the awards of the day.
