**Central and Eastern High Boys
Do Well in M. A. C. Track
and Field Preliminaries.**

**FIGHT IT OUT WITH
RAPIDS AND KAZOO**

**Four Teams Have Chance for
First Honors — Six Others
Qualify Some Contestants.**

East Lansing, Mich., May 25.—

As a result of the preliminaries in the track events of the Michigan Interscholastic track meet held today under the auspices of the M. A. C., the finals tomorrow promise to be a four-cornered affair among Detroit Central, Detroit Eastern, Kalamazoo and Grand Rapids Central.

All four schools, with the exception of Detroit Central, qualified men in four of the five events run off today. Other schools to qualify one or more men were Pontiac, Grand Rapids South, Detroit Northwestern, Lansing and Adrian.

When the starter's whistle blew a field of more than 250 athletes representing 22 schools had been registered. Monroe, Otsego, Battle Creek and St. Joseph failed to put in an appearance today but are expected to take part in the field events tomorrow.

In the preliminary heat of the 220-yard dash, Brown of Detroit Central, finished third, but took first place in the semi-finals in a close race; Rockwell of Detroit Eastern, being hit in foot behind the line, won a second.

The 440-yard dash honors went to Grand Rapids Central, Hanson finishing first in the initial heat, and Jones first in the second. Hanson of Detroit Eastern, was a close second to Hanson in the second heat.

Brown of Detroit Central, came nearest to lowering a record when he did the 220-yard dash in 32.25, the Michigan interscholastic record being 31.15. Hanson of Pontiac took second in the preliminary heat, but crossed the tape first in the initial semi-final. Olsson of Detroit Eastern, and Hanson took second honors in this event.

500 Yards
In the hurdles, McCallum and Brockway of Detroit Central, each took a preliminary heat. Spurrier of Detroit Eastern, finished second. The finals in the dashes and the preliminaries in the field events will start tomorrow at 1 p. m.
