

Grand Rapids Fares Well in Track Prelims

East Lansing, Mich., May 26.—Preliminaries in the track events of the Michigan Interscholastic meet were run off Friday with a field of more than 220 athletes, representing twenty-two schools registered. Detroit Central, Detroit Eastern, Kalamazoo and Grand Rapids Central qualified men in four of the five events. Other schools to qualify one or more men were Pontiac, Grand Rapids South, Detroit Northwestern, Lansing and Adrian.

Grand Rapids placed men in the following events: 220-yard low hurdles, Beard; 100-yard dash, Hopkins; 1220-yard dash, Houston; 440-yard dash, Houston, Jones. Grand Rapids South placed only one man, Simons, in the 440, while Grand Rapids Union did not qualify any men. The finals were scheduled Saturday afternoon.
