

ENTRIES CLOSE FOR LONG RACE MEMORIAL DAY

Good Competition Expected in Cross-Country Around Belle Isle Next Wednesday.

Good competition is expected in the fifth annual Michigan championship cross-country run to be staged at Belle Isle under the auspices of the local Y. M. C. A. next Wednesday.

Entries closed Saturday and Raymond N. Sellon, who has charge of the contest, announced a larger number of probable starters than ever before. The start and finish of the race will be at the athletic field, Belle Isle. The contestants will run around the island once. The starting gun will be fired at 10:30 o'clock Memorial Day.

Numerous distance runners from Detroit high schools and athletic clubs have entered as well as athletes from the smaller colleges and Y. M. C. A.'s in the state. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded the first, second and third men to finish, while a special bronze medallion will be presented to every man completing the distance in 35 minutes or less.

Cecil Addington of Albion college, holds the present record of 27 minutes, 40 2-5 seconds.
