MCKINSTRY WINNER OF FIRST PLACE

Emerges With Biggest Totals of Points in 'Finals' of Sixth Grade Meet.

Class finishes marked the finale of the Detroit sixth grade schools indoor meet, held in the Central high school gymnasium Tuesday, many of the events having to be re-run before a decision could be reached.

The winners in the various districts into which the sixth graders are divided participated and the results show that the youngsters' athletic ability is well distributed over the city.

McKinstry school won the meet with 10 points, with Trowbridge George tied for third place. No school tied races, winning in the first time of 42 seconds. Trowbridge won a first in the high jump, with a good leap of four feet six inches. Tappan just beat out Estabrook in the soccer dribble. Graustally won the class B jump. Beard and Field schools won the two dashes after several tied races.

The meeting of the eighth graders Saturday and the sixth graders Tuesday brought to an end the indoor meets of the Detroit grade schools, 13 of which have been held in the past two weeks in all sections of the city and including all grades from the sixth to the eighth.

The excellent showing of the boy athletes from all over the city speaks well for the instruction and help given by the physical education department of the board of education, which is doing all in its power to foster competitive recreation and the sporting spirit among the boys of Detroit.
