

ALGER BOYS ARE BEST IN TRACK MEET

Some Excellent Marks Are Made in Grade School Finals Held at Detroit "Y."

Some excellent marks were set in the finals of the Detroit grade schools indoor meet held at the Y. M. C. A. gymnasium Saturday. Only those schools which had been victorious in the preliminary meets during the month took part in the finals and the competition proved to be keen, causing the youthful athletes to extend themselves to obtain the gold medal which went to the winner in each event.

In the eighth grade events the Alger school came out on top with 17 points, Van Dyke being close behind with 15. In the Junior high series Northwestern led with 25 points, followed by Southwestern with 22, and Northwestern with 20. Northwestern had a boy "plow" in nearly every event, while Southwestern had two boys and two seconds in only four events. Alger school had one first and four seconds. The high jump to class II of the eighth grade schools was especially good, the winner clearing the bar at 4 feet 11 inches.
