

COLTS SURPRISE; HOLD CENTRAL TO CLOSE SCORE

**Track Meet Saturday Evening
is Won by Blue and White,
Which Has Eight-Point Margin.**

Contrary to all expectations, Northwestern high school's elder squad held Central high's tracksters to an eight-point win in a dual track meet between the two schools in the Northwestern gym Saturday evening, the final score being Central 41-2, Northwestern 25-2.

The Cass avenue runners acquired an early lead, the score at the end of the first four events being 27 to 9, Central up. This was too much for the Northwestern elder men to overcome and the second Col team fell before a blue and white aggregation in two days. Coming from behind after four events already had all gone to Central, Northwestern started a steady rise and all but overtook the Central lead.

In the first event, the 25-yard dash, Central won all three places. Everett of Central added to the Central total in the mile run, next on the program, by taking first. In the 27-yard hurdles Central repeated the performance of the first event, taking all three places. Captain Sprague of Northwestern placed his team in the running by capturing first in the 410-yard dash.

First and second and a tie for third place in the high jump went to the Colts. Dixon played first in the heaping event, Steinhoff, heretofore unknown, took second in the high jump.

Clayton, Northwestern's original speed merchant, took first in the 220-yard dash. Drabkowski of Central, who finished second to Clayton, stumbled in the first lap of the race but made a speedy recovery, which saved third place for him.

The pole vault resulted in a tie for first honors between Hutchings of Central and Thompson of Northwestern. The height was 9 feet 1 inch. Both men had stayed in the lead all season the evening previous and were not at their best.

440-yard dash—Sprague, Northwestern, first; P. Phumphy, Central, second; E. Phumphy, third. Time, 1:15 seconds.

High jump—Mason, Northwestern, first; Steinhoff, Northwestern, second; Kennard, Northwestern, and Hopkins, Central, tied for third. Height, 4 feet 11 1/2 inches.

220-yard dash—Clayton, Northwestern, first; Drabkowski, Central, second; McCallum, Central, third. Time, 2:14.

Pole vault—Thompson, Northwestern, and Hutchings, Central, tied for first; Shuy, Central, third. Height, 9 feet 1 inch.

Shotput—Pridon, Northwestern, first; Brown, Central, second; Brooks, Central, third. Distance, 26 feet 14 inches.

Half mile—Jules, Northwestern, first; Cooper, Central, second; Rosenzweig, Central, third. Time, 2:16.

Relay—Won by Central but not allowed because of foul on both sides. Time, 1:12.
