

HASTINGS WINS BI-COUNTY TRACK MEETING HONORS

Victors Score Six Firsts, Three Seconds and Two Thirds for First Place—Charlotte Ranks Second.

Hastings, Mich., May 24.—In spite of the rain fully 500 enthusiastic students from Barry and Eaton counties today witnessed the second annual bi-county interscholastic track and field meet of the high schools which was won by Hastings with Charlotte second, Bellevue third.

Other schools represented were Eaton Rapids, Grand Ledge and Vermontville. Woodland, Middleville and Nashville failed to show up. The events resulted as follows:

128-yard hurdle—Max Murray, Charlotte, first; Sheltonham, Vermontville, second; Hawkins, Vermontville, third. Time, 17 4-8 seconds.

Shot-put—Murray, Charlotte, first; Janousek, Vermontville, second; Sage, Hastings, third. Distance, 37 feet 2 inches.

100-yard dash—Dryer, Bellevue, first; Murray, Charlotte, second; Pratt, Grand Ledge, third. Time, 11 seconds.

Pole vault—Power, Hastings, first; Ellis, Charlotte, second; Webster, Eaton Rapids, third. Height, 8 feet 10 inches.

One mile run—Craig, Hastings, first; Hossein, Hastings, second. Time, 5 minutes 11-5 seconds.

Baseball throw—Hart, Bellevue, first; Near, Charlotte, second; Taylor, Vermontville, third. Distance, 297 feet 10 inches.

220-yard dash—Dryer, Bellevue, first; Pratt, Grand Ledge, second; Murray, Charlotte, third. Time, 27 2-5 seconds.

High jump—Thomson, Bellevue, first; Sage, Hastings, second; Snyder, Charlotte, third. Height, 2 feet 8 3-4 inches.

440-yard run—Craig, Hastings, first; Dryer, Bellevue, second; Clark, Eaton Rapids, third. Time, 53 1-2 seconds.

Hop step jump—Fuller, Hastings, first; Snyder, Charlotte, second; Randall, Hastings, third. Distance, 88 feet 8 inches.

Half mile run—Craig, Hastings, first; Rossein, Hastings, second; Snyder, Charlotte, third. Time, 2:19 2-5.

Broad jump—Fuller, Hastings, first; Murray, Charlotte, second; Sheltonham, Vermontville, third. Distance, 16 feet 9 inches.

Relay race—Hastings, first and second. Time, 1:58 2-5.

Miss Helen Childoster, of Hastings, won the girls' steeple in tennis. The baseball game between Nashville and Bellevue to decide the bi-county championship was postponed until Monday on account of rain.
