

# Rockford Is First in Kent Field Meet

With a total of 70 points Rockford High school won the fifth annual track and field meet of the Kent County Interscholastic Athletic association at Ramona Athletic park Friday afternoon. Lowell High was second with 28½ and Cedar Springs placed third with 22. Kent City was fourth with 15 while Grandville got only 1½. Three association records were broken.

High individual honors went to Otto Spannenberg of Rockford with 30 1-5 points. In nine of the 12 events he made good scores, winning firsts in four events.

In the 50-yard dash the first event, M. Banks of Lowell made the distance in five seconds flat, lowering the previous record by two-fifths of a second. Nott of Lowell set a new record for the mile run, making the distance in 5:17. Rice of Cedar Springs broke the record for the discus throw, making a mark of 102 feet 11 inches, breaking the previous record, held by himself, by 1 foot 11 inches.

In a rather loose game Cedar Springs High baseball team won the county championship by defeating Rockford 8 to 6, winning The Grand Rapids Press baseball cup for the year. The class B baseball game for the Grand Rapids Press baseball cup to have been played in the morning was called off.
