

Y. M. C. A. TO HOLD X-COUNTRY RACE

Will Stage Annual Run on Turkey Day.

Detroit Y. M. C. A. will hold its tenth annual cross-country run and second nnnual walking Thanksgiving day at 10 a. m.

The marathon affair will start at the corner of Grand River and the Grand boulevard, the course then running eastward on the south side of the boulevard to Woodward, then

of the boulevard to Woodward, then turning around the parking, going back on the north side or the Grand boulevard to the finish at Pexter. The walking race will cover the same course.

Frizes will be awarded to the first 10 of the contestants to finish as follows: Gold to the winner, silver to the second and third places and bronze medals to the next nine. In addition to the above individual prizes a trophy will be given to the club or organization whose team of five men secure the smallest number of points.

The races are open to all men 17-1-2 years of age and over who declare themselves to be amateurs. An entry fee of 25 cents must accompany application blank which should be returned to J. Truit Maxwell, physical director of the Y. M. C. A. before noon November 25.
