LAST YEAR athletics in the Ann Arbor High School took on a different aspect. Track, especially, which had been weak for several years, was revived and made a very commendable showing during the season.

Beginning last October, under the direction of Director Olds, a cross country team was organized and trained for several weeks. Thanksgiving Day the team went to Detroit and participated in the annual Y. M. C. A. meet held there. Running over a four-mile course and competing against a large number of state colleges, Ann Arbor High succeeded in winning the state championship. Albion, Alma, Hillsdale, Kalamazoo, Muskegon, M. A. C., and the Detroit Y. M. C. A., as well as several Detroit schools, took part in the meet.

Shortly after the opening of the second semester a meet was held in the local gymnasium against the freshmen of Ypsi Normal, Ann Arbor winning, 57 to 34. This meet gave the locals good practice for the Detroit schools, which they met later in the season. The following week Detroit Northern was smothered in the local gymnasium. C. MacGregor made a sensational run, winning the mile in 4:47½. At this time several men were ruled ineligible, either physically or scholastically. Captain Dale Hause, who had been doing marvelous work all the season, had reached the age limit and was barred from further activity. Floyd Palmer was elected captain to succeed him, and was found very efficient in his new position.
