

EASTERN VICTOR OVER NORTHERN TRACK ATHLETES

Brinker's Triumph in Mile One of Meet's Big Upsets—Eskimos Exceptionally Weak.

Eastern's track athletes continued their victorious sweep of the city Saturday night at Northern high, when they victimized the Eskimo squad, 67 to 23.

Aside from one or two events, in which the Indians were exceptionally weak or did not have men competing, the Northern trackmen were helpless when opposed to the well-coached Eastern runners.

Brinker led off with a victory in the mile. The win of the Eastern high lad over Rice of Northern was one of the meet's big upsets. In the city interscholastic last winter Rice was the runner who staged such a battle with Cooper, the Blue and White athlete, for first place in the long jaunt. Coaches predicted that the big fellow would be a great deal better this spring.

Sorter was a consistent winner for the Orange and Black, placing first in both hurdle events and in the 880-yard dash. There were no accomplishments during the evening of an extraordinary nature and none that have not been equalled or bettered already this season.

In the pole vault Eastern fell down badly, not an Indian jumper being able to place, while Monihan, Ertell and Burton won the nine points for the Eskimos. The jumping of Ertell, winner of the event, was poor, only 7 ft. 6 in. being made.
