The local track team went to Kalamazoo last Saturday to compete in the Kalamazoo college Interscholastic meet. It was a bitter cold day and rain fell in torrents, but the boys gave a good account of themselves, finishing fifth in the meet with fourteen points. Kalamazoo was first with 45; Cass City second, 25 2-3; Battle Creek third, 24; Grand Rapids fourth with 16 and Paw Paw next. Nine schools besides the above mentioned competed, and finished below the locals. Mumbrue won second in the 50 yard dash, the 100 yard dash, and fourth in the running broad jump.
