

# SISTER CITY WINS TRACK MEET HONORS

ST. JOSEPH IS POOR THIRD IN  
CONTENTS OF COUNTY  
HIGH SCHOOLS

The second annual track and field meet which was held Saturday at the Twin City Athletic field which was generously donated by Floyd Fitzsimmons of Benton Harbor, resulted somewhat disastrously for the local high school squad, they finishing up in third place. The maize and blue was completely out played in every department by the sister city team, which copped the meet with a grand total of 59 5-6 points. The finishing places of the different schools was as follows:

Benton Harbor—59 5-6.  
Gallen—17.  
St. Joseph—14 5-6.  
Three Oaks—14.  
Stevensville—5.  
East Claire—1-3.

High schools from the entire county were represented in the meet, which occupied the entire day. Benton Harbor captured six firsts, was tied twice for first place and took six seconds. St. Joseph took but one first place, this being captured by Hendrix in the 100 yard dash.

St. Joseph, however, did carry off the honors in baseball, taking Water-vliet into camp by the overwhelming score of 14 to 5. The local school must now play Gallen on Wednesday of this week to determine the championship of the county, for which a large trophy will be awarded.
