

## BATTLE CREEK LOSES BY ONLY HALF POINT

Detroit Eastern Captures Interscholastic at Lansing  
By Final Spurt.

Lansing, May 31.—Detroit Eastern high school nosed out Battle Creek in the annual interscholastic meet at East Lansing today by half a point. Battle Creek got 24 points and Detroit Eastern 24½. Battle Creek led easily until the broad jump and hammer events when the Detroit school with 23½ points, took fourth in the class A half-mile relay in which Battle Creek had failed to place.

Kalamazoo won third place with 22½ points and was a strong contender at all stages of the meet, the failure of the team's distance runners probably losing them the meet.

Individual scoring honors went to Turnbull of Detroit Eastern with 12 points. Walker of Gobieville, McCallum of Detroit Central and Sweet of Battle Creek tied for second honors.
