

## HASTINGS WINNER OF BI-COUNTY MEET

CHARLOTTE, June 7.—The Third Annual Bi-County Interscholastic athletic meet of Barry and Eaton counties was held in Charlotte Friday, and Hastings ran away with the meet, capturing 69 1-3 points, with Bellevue second with 17 1-3; Grand Lodge third, 15; Charlotte fourth, 10 1-3; Nashville fifth, 3; Vermontville sixth, 2; and Olivet seventh, 0. Hastings captured the field day pennant, the boys' doubles and singles, and the girls' singles in tennis. Olivet won the girls' doubles in tennis. Grand Lodge won the relay and Craig of Hastings won the all around. The baseball game between Bellevue and Hastings for the bi-county championship was called in the first inning because of rain. It will be played off Thursday next at Nashville.
