

RECORDS HOLD IN ARENA MEET

Few Upsets Occur in Dope;
Track and Field Events
Are Poorly Staged.

Detroit's first and therefore biggest indoor track, field, relay and gymnastic carnival in years was held at the Arena yesterday afternoon under the auspices of the Y. M. C. A.

No three-ring circus had anything on the meet in the number of events staged at once. At one time on the floor there was a gymnastic competition with a number of entries, the pole vault, the high jump, the shot put and sprints.

At the other end of the floor in a far corner was a band, which had mania for playing lively airs just as interest in a race was at its height or when an announcement was about to be made.

POOR TIME MADE.

A loose canvas on the floor kept the runners from making very good time. The men in the field events were also a bit handicapped, but as a whole the meet was run off very successfully, a crowd of more than 1,000 spectators turning out.

There were one or two upsets in the dope, but most of the favorites came through as per schedule. Western State Normal College turned out with two sprinters, who whipped the University of Michigan candidates, Losch and Lashmet, in the 50-yard dash. Lashmet was eliminated in the heats, while the best that Losch could do was place third to George Walker and Clarence Altenburg, of the Normal School, in the finals.

LOSES AT TURN.

G. G. Wetzel, of Michigan Agricultural College, defeated L. Butler, of the University of Michigan and the favorite, in the 440 in a close finish. Butler ran into Wetzel on a turn and this prevented him from overtaking and perhaps beating out the Aggie.

Carl Johnson came down with the Michigan team from Ann Arbor, but competed only in the high jump due to an injury. He won this easily at 5 feet 3 inches.

Walter Westbrook, former Eastern High School athlete, took the pole vault for Michigan, with 11 feet 6 inches, while the best that the second place man could do was 11 feet.

Gustav Rathgeb, who has won gymnastic honors at Brussels, San Francisco and other points east and west, defeated the field for the all-around gymnastic title, with a total of 242.5 points as against 239 for Adolf DeBuck, of the Y. M. C. A. The Y. M. C. A. gymnastic team finished first for the team honors with 558½ points, while the Catholic Bohemia Society was second with 560 points.
