

EASTERN DEFEATS CASS TRACK TEAM

**Toepner's Work Helps Mates
Pile Up 76 to 18 Score.**

Eastern high school track team defeated Cass Tech, 76 to 18, in a dual meet at the former's gymnasium Tuesday night. In the eleven events staged, Cass succeeded in finishing first only in two.

Toepner and Brinker, star track athletes for the Eastern aggregation, shared individual honors during the session. Toepner won first place in the low hurdles besides placing in four of the other events, while his mate, Brinker, copped the mile run in 4:57:04, the fastest time ever clocked at Eastern gymnasium for this distance.

Several hundred fans witnessed the meet.
